

SNOWBIRD USAGE ADJUSTMENT POLICY

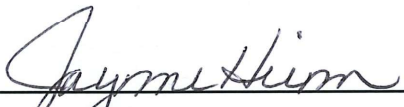
A resident of City of Rice Lake's municipal water or sewer system can apply for a Snowbird zero usage billing adjustment under the following conditions:

- Home must be an owner-occupied single-family residence
- Residence must have cellular metered water readings
- Owner account must be paid up to date and in good standing
- An application must be completed annually
- Water usage must be less than 100 gallons each effective month or regular usage charges will apply
- Owner account will continue to be billed the monthly services charges and late penalties, where applicable
- This Policy is in effect November to March, unless City is notified sooner

This Policy may be revoked at any time at the discretion of the City Council.

Repealer: This policy hereby repeals and replaces any former Snowbird Usage Adjustment Policy.

Effectuation: This policy was approved and adopted by Rice Lake City Council on March 23, 2026.
